## SERMON QUESTIONS

### **This Week's Readings:**

Ps 19 Neh 8:1-3,5-6,8-10 1Cor 12:12-31a Lk 4:14-21

Read Luke 4:14-20.

1.a. Reread vv. 16b-17. Imagine a slow-motion action scene. Luke is creating suspense. Everybody's eyes are on Jesus.  
b. Now read what Jesus read in Luke 4:18-19. (Two texts from Isaiah are mixed together here: 61:1-2 and 58:6.)

2. Jesus' main mission is "to bring good news to the poor." From Sunday's sermon, who are the poor? How are you "the poor"? What's the good news?

3. Jesus twice emphasizes "release" or "freedom." Releasing, or setting people free, is a key activity of Jesus' ministry: release from (or forgiveness for) sins and release from oppressive evil. Tell a story about how you have experienced such freedom.

4. To be free from sin and oppressive evil is to be restored to relationship with God and with each other. Read 1 Cor. 12:12-31 for a metaphor of one body, many parts to illustrate the unity and diversity in God's family. From the text, what are some distorted ways we think about ourselves and other members of the body?

5. Read 1 Cor. 12:24b-25. What should all members of the body remember and do?

6. What part has God arranged for you to play in the body? How are you playing it?
