- We are starting a new school year here in Nicaragua. The teachers and Sarah recently attended a retreat - a time for learning new techniques, being challenged as well as encouraged, worshiping and praying, laughing and bonding, and planning for the year to come. Nicaragua faces a lot of challenges but we are facing them with full tanks!
- We have short term teams joining us from Trenton Wesleyan, The Bridge (Kanata) and Impact (Mansfield, Ohio). It is so encouraging to see the work moving along.
- Please pray as we wait to hear back from Immigration about our residency renewal.
