This Week's Readings:

Ps 118:1-2,19-29 Zech 9:9-12 1Tim 6:12-16 Lk 19:28-40

1. What are some of the ways that reflecting on the kingship and messianic element of Jesus' identity help to prepare us for Holy week?
2. In what ways is the exultation of Jesus in the triumphal entry (Luke 19:29-40) the same as the exultation of an earthly ruler? In what ways are they different?
3. How do you understand the glory of God?
4. Read these three passages: Luke 2:8-20, Luke 19:36-40, Revelation 7:9-10. What do these passages have in common? How do they differ in their emphasis on glory?
5. What are some of the ways that we bring glory to God?
6. How central is the glory of God to your understanding of the spiritual life?
7. In what ways does the focus on His glory impact how we live?
