 **“Our Lives Are Not Our Own”**
The EFC is intervening in the *Lamb* case, which will be heard in the Supreme Court of BC this fall. The outcome will determine whether restrictions to medical assistance in dying will be lifted, making it available to anyone who decides they no longer want to live.
