Revelation 7:9-17 Psalm 23 Acts 9:36-43 John 10:22-30

SERMON QUESTIONS

Hear God's Voice

1. Read John 10:22-30. What do you learn about hearing the voice of God in this passage? Who hears? What are the implications for you?
2. What gets in the way of you hearing God's voice? What changes in you might assist your ability to hear God?
3. Read Acts 9:36-43 and re-read John 10:22-30. Discuss some ways or places that we notice God's voice or, in other words, what are some avenues through which we receive God's revelation?
4. Read Psalm 23 and Revelation 7:9-17. Considering all four texts we have read so far, how do you know that it is God's voice you are hearing and not another's? Or, what are some characteristics of God's voice?
5. Read John 10:27. What does this verse indicate you will do when you hear God's voice? Offer some specific examples.
6. Concisely share one way you have heard the voice of God during this time together. Pray for each other, specifically for further discernment and response considering what each one has heard.
