SERMON QUESTIONS

This Week's Readings:

Ps 105:1-4, Ex 3:1-15, Rom 12:9-21, Matt 6:1-21

The Lord's Prayer, Part Two: Hallowed Be Your Name

1. Have you ever had a supernatural experience during which you believed God was revealing God's self to you? Tell a story about such an occasion. Alternatively tell a modern story you've heard about someone else who had a theophany, that is, an appearance or revelation of God.
2. Read Exodus 3:1-15. What do you learn about God's name?
3. Read the Lord's Prayer (Matt. 6:9-13) with focus on "hallowed be your name." What does it mean to hallow God's name? Give some examples of how God's name is dishonoured or misused (besides using God's name as a curse word which is a common and important example).
4. In their book titled LORD, Teach Us, William Willimon and Stanley Hauerwas say: "The Lord's Prayer is like a bomb ticking in church, waiting to explode and demolish our temples to false gods...any time you make a statement like "Holy be your name," you have made a revolutionary claim that promises to land you in the middle of conflict..." Why? What does "hallowed be your name" invite or change?
5. How might the front-end emphasis on God's honour, kingdom and purpose (vv. 9 and 10) affect the following prayers for your own needs (vv. 11-13)?
6. We made four points in our service: To hallow God's name means to seek his fame, to commit to a lifestyle that honours him, to refrain from making your own name great, and to return to the fear of the Lord. Pause to hear one thing that God is speaking to you about honouring him. Share a related prayer request. Pray together.
