A place where we experience God's transforming love through the Holy Spirit, by faith, the Word of God, worship and prayer;


A people being transformed by the love and grace of Jesus as we practice authentic community;

Fall Re-opening of Schools



Decision time is fast approaching for the provincial government, local school boards, teachers and parents. Local school boards must submit plans to the government by August 4 for review before boards can implement their programs in this COVID-19 world.

Boards are wrestling with options from on-line learning exclusively to full-time classroom teaching through the week. Parents and teachers are already highly-stressed. Many parents have to juggle childcare with full-time work. Some parents contemplate dropping out of the workforce if schools do not reopen full time. And many kids miss their classmates. Please pray...

- For God's wisdom to guide the decisions of the provincial government and local school boards.
- That school boards will find a way to provide schooling for children that best meets the needs of families without creating another surge in COVID-19 cases.
- That children will get a good education whatever the Ottawa school boards decide.

- For teachers to find inner peace whatever the teaching system in coming months.
