Matagalpa, Nicaragua



Nine years ago, we landed in sweltering Managua with four small, tired kids and a pile of suitcases and duct-taped bins. We had a little Spanish and a lot of faith. You prayed us through some amazing times of ministry, outreach, church and school growth, and lives transformed by the Gospel.

Prayer Points:

- The kids were in a hit-and-run accident while riding the 15 passenger van that is used for their school transportation. Glass exploded into the driver's face, leaving many cuts. It was a miracle that no students were hurt. Traffic in Managua can be dangerous and intense and the kids have an hour long ride each way. Pray for their protection and peace of mind.
- Pray for more workers to join us! We are juggling a lot of responsibilities and need more help. There are [many ways](#) to get involved. (If you know of people who have a heart for missions, please pass this along.)
- Ryan is heading to Alamikamba with a group of Nicaraguan pastors and leaders for another round of hurricane relief. Thousands of families are still suffering and do not have the resources to rebuild. Pray for their safety and for many moments to pray with, encourage, and bless them.

Lenten Devotional


