- As we are sending our first missionary to minister with Treaty 7 First Nations in southern Alberta! Becki Pound has partnered with Norwood and other community sponsors to organize a convoy of vehicles to deliver winter clothing, blankets, baby items, and non-perishable food, to families with children.
- For Rick Pybus, who has just returned from Edmonton to visit the work and encourage the ministry. Despite the challenges from the Covid-19 epidemic, the church is in good spirits and is developing a core of about 25 dedicated leaders and workers with a vision to minister and reach out to the community. Pastor Nick and Kayla are continuing to preach and provide good leadership.
- Two members of the Norwood congregation were lost and unaccounted for. After the church prayed and police were informed, both were found. One young woman was joyously located and restored. The other (who had miraculously reunited with his mother at Norwood a few weeks earlier) was deceased, but he had come to faith in Jesus and had been transformed from an "atheist" to a ministering member of our church!
