Ottawa Food Bank



Demands on local food banks are rising sharply as many residents grapple with job losses and inflation. The Ottawa food bank and its network of 100+ member agencies feed tens of thousands of low-income people annually. One agency fed almost five times as many local residents in March 2022 as it did before the pandemic.

Please pray that...

- The food needs of low-income residents will be met through food banks and other channels.
- More churches and individual Christians will step forward to help collect food and stock the shelves of food banks.
- Volunteers will fill all the needs of food banks, ranging from transportation to administration.
- Ottawa-area residents, including Christians, will increase financial support to food banks.
- Local governments and businesses will work together to help low-income residents with housing and jobs.
