From Broken Hearts to Burning Hearts

On Sunday we will look at the Easter story of the two disciples on the road to Emmaus, only told in Luke's Gospel. The narrative ends with a meal, reminding us of the significance of breaking bread together. Steve Bell, Canadian song writer and Christian thinker, [offers this challenge](#) as we reflect and prepare: "Let us pay attention to, and fan into burning flame, our human instinct to share food and drink hospitably, especially in the context of tragedy and loss. During these times we are participating in revelation, in Gospel hope and in loving witness to the redeeming love of God in Christ. It is Christ who will, in the fullness of time, redeem and draw every tear, every dashed hope, every broken heart, to the eternal banquet of God's kingdom."
